Gooding City Council Minutes

Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Gooding, Idaho was called to order at 7:00 pm in the Gooding Municipal Building, 308 5th Ave West, Gooding, Idaho on May 17, 2021. Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilman Arkoosh.

Roll Call

Present were Mayor Brekke, Councilpersons Arkoosh, Cram, Pierce and Shepherd.

Changes to Agenda (Idaho Code 67-2343 Sec 4 (b))

Councilman Cram made a motion to add John Arkoosh to discuss the Water Call to the agenda. Motion seconded by Councilman Pierce. Motion carried by roll call vote.

Present were Lloyd McLeod, Margie McLeod and John Arkoosh.

Trailer Coach Parking Ordinance: Chief Fisher submitted a newly revised draft of the Trailer Coach Parking Ordinance. Attorney Ash requested this item be moved to the next meeting so the Council could fully review the proposed ordinance.

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Lloyd McLeod; Request Water Rights/Access for 1021 Colorado Street: Margie McLeod stated she has not received the information the Council has requested at this time. Attorney Ash requested the McLeod's also bring a legal description of the proposed right of way.

Gooding City & Gooding Recreation District Agreement: Item is tabled at this time.

New Business

John Arkoosh; Water Call: John Arkoosh gave an update on the current water call and curtailment and stated if the City would like to join the Big Wood/Little Wood Users Association in the call the Notice of Intent would need to be submitted by May 19, 2021. Councilman Cram made a motion to authorize Attorney Ash to submit the Notice of Intent to join the Big Wood/Little Wood Users Association. Motion seconded by Councilman Pierce. Motion carried.

2021 Mental Health Awareness Month Proclamation: Councilman Pierce moved to allow the Mayor to sign the 2021 Mental Health Awareness Month Proclamation from the Walker Center. Motion seconded by Councilman Arkoosh. Motion carried.

Phantom Fireworks Application Approval: Councilman Arkoosh made a motion to approve Phantom Fireworks Application to sell fireworks at Ridley's Family Market parking lot. Motion seconded by Councilman Cram. Motion carried.

Approval for O'Reillys Final Plat: A final plat has been submitted to the County Planning & Zoning. The final plat is required to have the Mayor's signature of approval. Councilman Cram made a motion to authorize the Mayor to sign O'Reillys final plat. Motion seconded by Councilman Arkoosh. Motion carried.

Airport Advisory Board Recommendation for Hanger Alternatives: A representative from the Airport Advisory Board was not present. Mayor asked to move this item forward to the next meeting.

Authorization for Mayor to Sign SF425 & SF271 for AIP 013-2019 Grant Closeout Approval for Runway Extension Project Phase II: Councilman Arkoosh made a motion to authorize the Mayor to sign SF425 and SF271 for the AIP 013-2019 Grant Closeout. Motion seconded by Councilman Cram. Motion carried.

Approval for T-O Engineers Invoice #13542, T-O Engineers Invoice #14120 & Request for Reimbursement #4 for Runway Extension Project Phase II: Councilman Arkoosh made a motion to approve T-O Engineers Invoice #13542 in the amount of 9,531.25, T-O Engineers Invoice #14120 in the amount of \$2,392.50 and Request for Reimbursement #4 in the amount of \$11,923.75. Motion seconded by Councilwoman Shepherd. Motion carried.

T-O Engineers Invoice #14122 for Gooding Airport Master Plan: Councilman Arkoosh made a motion to approve T-O Engineers Invoice #14122 in the amount of \$6,368.75. Motion seconded by Councilman Cram. Motion carried.

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Schedule Budget Work Session: Budget work session has been scheduled for June 7, 2021 at 5:00 pm and June 21, 2021 at 5:00 pm.

Department Reports

City Council: Nothing to report.

Police Chief Dave Fisher: Nothing to report.

Public Works Director Larry Bybee:

- Working on prices for tire disposal from the racetrack at the Airport.
- The City has been awarded a \$4,200 grant from South Central Public Health District based on the Park Assessment Survey. Last year the City was able to install lighting and paint to the West Park restrooms. We will add \$1,800 from the parks maintenance line and will purchase bark for the playground equipment in all the parks.
- The new cardboard recycling containers have arrived and seem to be working well.
- The streets crew has been spraying alleys.
- Supervisor Noel Edwards has purchased over 1,000 MXU's valued around \$180 each for a total of \$200 at an auction. The water crew will be installing them. This will decrease meter reading time from 3 days to 1 day when the project is complete.
- The South Well has faulted out.
- The fire hydrant at 205 N Main was backed into and is now replaced.

City Clerk Hollye Lierman: Nothing to report.

There being no further business Councilman Arkoosh made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion seconded by Councilman Cram. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:09 p.m.
