Gooding City Council Minutes

Special Meeting

The special meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Gooding, Idaho was called to order at 5:30 pm in the Gooding Municipal Building, 308 5th Ave West, Gooding, Idaho on July 12, 2021.

Roll Call

Present were Mayor Brekke, Councilpersons Arkoosh, Pierce, Shepherd. Councilman Cram was not present.

Employees

Present were City Clerk Hollye Lierman, Public Works Director Larry Bybee and Attorney Brendan Ash.

New Business:

Montana Street Paving Agreement with Gooding Fire District: Mayor Brekke stated he was contacted by Fire Commissioner David Hults regarding paving of Montana Street. The Fire District has hired Western Construction to pave the parking lot at the new station. The Fire District received a quote from Western Construction to pave Montana Street from Highway 46 to 21st Ave East in the amount of \$57,975.00. This would save the City approximately \$8,000 if Western Construction were to do the parking lot and Montana Street together. The Council would like to repay the Fire District over a 4 year period for the paving. Attorney Ash advised the Council in order to do so he would recommend adding a non appropriations clause to the agreement. Discussion was held to discuss streets funding, capital improvement funding and general funding to pay for the paving. City Clerk Lierman stated rather than depleting the Streets Fund to pay a one-time payment of \$57,975 from the General Fund. Councilwoman Shepherd made a motion to approve paying the Gooding Fire District \$57,975 for the paving of Montana Street from Highway 46 to 21st Ave East from the General Fund. Motion seconded by Councilman Pierce. Motion carried.

Airport Advisory Board Appointments: Mayor Brekke stated there are 2 vacancies on the Airport Advisory Board. He has contacted Bobbie Nash, Tyler Hatfield, Ted Pierson and Todd Thomas to see if they would be willing to fill the vacancies. Bobbie Nash has not replied at this time. Tyler Hatfield has declined the offer. Ted Pierson and Todd Thomas have both stated they are willing to fill the vacancy. A council representative will also need to be appointed.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 5:55 pm.
