The regular meeting of the Gooding Urban Renewal Agency (GURA) of Gooding, Idaho was called to order on December 3, 2020 in the Gooding Municipal Building, 308 5th Ave West, at 9:00 am.

Visitors: Present was Betty Fredericksen.

Minutes: Gaines made a motion to approve the November 5, 2020 meeting minutes. Motion seconded by Yerion. Motion carried.

Treasurers Report: The November 2020 Statement was presented. Ending fund balance as of November 30, 2020 is \$53,465.01.

Bybee made a motion to approve the treasures report. Motion seconded by Yerion. Motion carried.

URA Area: Yerion will get the KML map from the County. The Board discussed steps to introduce the URA to the public. Ideas were to add something to the City website, a paragraph in the Camas Courier, an insert in the Community Newsletter each month, something that includes the history of the Board, accomplishments and future plans. They discussed reaching out to KMVT to help inform citizens. It was agreed to create an eye catching flyer that includes where the money comes from, where the money goes, what the intentions are for URA and to include the URA statutes. Bolton and Bybee will meet to create a flyer to present to the Board at the next meeting. Bolton suggested creating a letter for citizens that are in the proposed URA area to invite them to the March 4th meeting for public input.

Bolton will meet with County Assessor Baldwin to discuss what the URA would have received in 2021 if the plan would have come together just to get a rough estimate on future revenue.
