- III. Old business
 - a. Infrastructure improvements update
Power is in for new hangar area with water being installed next week. Larry is developing a formal plan for the city with reference to connection fees for any future hangars to be built. 3 lots are available with three phase power. ASOS continues to be OTS officially, Contractor wants \$700 to fix the unit
Action: Board requests the City pay the \$700 to resolve the ASOS issue.
 - b. Runway Construction update
Runway construction
Rick Patton from TO engineers gave briefing on next phase of Runway construction and Master Plan. Second phase of Construction to begin on or about Aug 1st. Rick is planning a second public meeting on the Master Plan, date will be sometime in the fall. We've had requests to have more wind socks located at both ends of the runway. Rick advised that wind sock on west end was part of the construction phases. He will look to see if one could be relocated to the east end as well. Rick also proposed designing an access road to the south side of the airport for future planning. The access point would be added to the master plan for future consideration. Board members thought that the old raceway access road could be used. Board will review. An additional possible runway extension

will be mentioned in the upcoming master plan if airport growth dictates another extension in the next ten years.

d. Airport Appreciation day update,

Appreciation day is scheduled for Sept 26th. Elks and Lions Clubs will be in charge of the food concessions with GAFA in charge of static displays, airplane rides and parking. Considered inviting classic cars clubs to participate.

Action: Larry to contact classic car clubs to see if any interest. City to draft a request for TO engineering to provide a \$500 sponsorship to the Airport appreciation day. Board will reach out to Idaho Dept of Aviation to see if their Kodiak aircraft would attend.

e. Vacancy on Board/ election:

Landunn Koyle's term is expired on the Board. Landunn has expressed an interest to stay on the board for the next term. Two other volunteers have expressed interest in the vacancy. Mickey Cockerham and Tyler Hatfield.

Action: City council to determine replacement for the expiring Board seat.

IV. Other issues

Dust issues were discussed at length about the silage pit area adjacent to the airport. Board concerned that future tenants will not purchase new hangar lots with the dust issue. Members of the Board will talk to the owner of the property to see if he will relocate these silage pits to other areas away from the airport. Discussion of providing water rights to that area to have the farmer farm that property and eliminate the dust of silage trucks in and out of the area.

Other item: Landing on the infield was discussed. Using the waiver provided by SUN airport still is cautioned against. Board advises No official Policy on the issue until other arguments are resolved.
