  - a. Infrastructure improvements update  
George Parker has power and water. Larry advised that no more infrastructure improvements will be accomplished at this time.  
ASOS continues to be OTS officially, Contractor waiting for payment and money for freight. Yearly service on AWOS is \$7300 which is about the same as the yearly maintenance on the NDB

  - b. Runway Construction update  
Runway construction  
Rick Patton from TO engineers gave briefing on next phase of Runway construction and Master Plan. Second phase of Construction to begin on or about Aug 10th. Rick is planning a second public meeting on the Master Plan, date will be sometime in the fall. The public meeting may have to be done online with a PowerPoint presentation. Rick gave plans on where new hangars could be located. Dale advised that some rec vehicles have been using the roads south of the runway. Fences and gates may be needed to curb the use. Rick advised that the FAA would most likely pay for the wildlife fences and gates.
